- Teach young staff to foster positive youth development
- Work closely with parents and families
- Model program participation and appropriate interaction with children
- Coordinate staff training

* Enhance leadership skills and build your resume Typically, Division Leaders have backgrounds in teaching, social work, psychology or youth development. Eligible candidates should have a bachelor's degree and/or previous leadership experience in youth development programs. The Division Leader position requires participation in a series of pre-camp training sessions in the late spring and facilitating five days of all-staff training before camp begins.
