

The State of New Orleans After School

There are more than 90 schools in New Orleans: fewer than half have 21st Century CCLC funds for after-school programming.



There is no dedicated revenue source for recreation/after school programming in Orleans Parish!



Did you know?

New Orleans invests roughly \$340 per K-12 school-aged child in expanded learning opportunities.

We know two things about that figure:

- a) that investment is uneven and
- b) it is not nearly enough to support a high-quality expanded learning experience for every child, a figure that, according to experts, would be closer to \$4,500 per child to cover school year participation costs.

Decreasing Childhood Obesity

1 in 3 children between 2-19 are obese or overweight.



Increasing Physical Activity

Only 51% of students currently attend at least one PE class a week while the other 49% of students receive less frequent or no PE.



Making Communities Safer

58% of children were exposed to violence within the previous year.



Reducing Cost of Sports Participation

60% of children who play sports have to pay a fee. Fees average \$401 per sport and disproportionately affect low-income students.
